## BOWLS FAR NORTH UMPIRES DUTIES

### ✓ **The Umpire's Duties:**

An Umpire should be appointed by, or on behalf of, the Controlling Body for the competition.

### ✓ **The Umpire's duties are as follows:**

- To check, before the game starts;
    - All bowls have a clearly visible, valid World Bowls Stamp imprinted on them.
    - The rink of play is the correct width in line with law 5.1 by measuring it; and
    - The pegs or discs on the side banks in the direction of play are the correct distances in line with laws 5.12 by measuring them.
  - The Umpire should measure any disputed shot or shots using suitable measuring equipment, such as described in law 10.
  - The Umpire should decide whether the distance of the mat from the rear and front ditches and the distance of the Jack or a bowl from the mat line are in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls or not.
  - The Umpire should make sure that all aspects of play are in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls.
  - The Umpire's decision is final in all circumstances except those relating to the meaning or interpretation of a law, in which case there will be a right of appeal to the Controlling Body.

## **Conditions of Play**

### **CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR ALL CENTRE FIXTURES ARE SUBJECT TO ALTERATION AS PER LAW 55.3.4**

#### **Please Note:**

If after 10 (ten) minutes of the scheduled starting time for a game one or more players are absent from a team the defaulting team will forfeit the game to their opponents.

**Champion of Champion Events:** *Where a player with dual membership wins a Championship event at more than one club, they must play the Centre Champion of Champion event for the first club at which they won the event.*

**Entries:** All entry forms and entry fees for Centre Fixtures are to be forwarded by Club Secretary to the Centre Manager: [secretary@bowlsfarnorth.co.nz](mailto:secretary@bowlsfarnorth.co.nz)

Centre Tournaments (Formerly National Club Fixtures) and Champion of Champion Fixtures are now being played on a 2 (two) life system.

**All Singles:** (including J1 and J1-5 Singles): 4 bowls each. 4 Rounds per day of 21 shots up. Time limit of 1¾ hours. No time limit for final or possible final. All players are to bring a marker where possible. All players to mark the round immediately following elimination as directed by the Tournament Controller.

**All Pairs:** (including J1-5 Pairs): 3 Bowls each. 4 Rounds per day of 18 completed ends. Time limit of 1¾ hours. No time limit final / possible final.

**Triples:** 2 Bowls each. 4 Rounds per day of 18 completed ends. Time limit of 1¾ hours. No time limit final/ possible final.

**Fours:** 2 Bowls each. 4 Rounds per day of 15 completed ends. Time limit of 1¾ hours. No time limit final/ possible final.

**Centre Mixed 2x4x2 Pairs:** 4 Bowls each. 2x4x2 format, 4 rounds of 16 completed ends.

**Restricting the movement of players during play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:

**Singles:** After the delivery of their third and fourth bowl.

**Pairs:** (Lead) After the delivery of their third bowl  
(Skip) After the delivery of their second bowl

**Triples:** (Lead) After the delivery of their second bowl  
(Two) After the delivery of their second bowl  
(Skip) After the delivery of each of their bowls

**Fours:** (Lead) After the second player in their team has played their second bowl  
(Two) After the delivery of their second bowl  
(Three) After the delivery of their second bowl  
(Skip) After the delivery of each of their bowls

---

**Centre Point to a Gold Star:** - Each winner of a Centre Fixture gains a point towards a Centre Gold Star.

**Centre Gold Star:** - Presented to a bowler who has five Centre points to their credit.

**Centre Gold Bar: -** Presented to a bowler who has 10 Centre points to their credit. Further Gold Bars presented in increments of five Centre points.  
**Centre Certificate:-** Certificates are awarded to winners of all Centre events. One certificate to be retained by the winners club and one for each team member “with the exception of the Interclub” also one certificate for each team member/ player will be awarded to the runner up of all Centre events, once again, “with the exception of the Interclub”.

**SLOW PLAY:-** A player in a time limit game can appeal to the Umpire or the Controlling Body for the time wasting or slow play of an opposing team or player. The Umpire or Controlling Body after warning the player or opposing team, can award an extra end or ends to be played after the time has expired. The Appellants can enforce this after the time has expired.  
**(Appendix A1, 4.7 Arrangements for dealing with slow play).**

**Centre: -** \$20 per player

**Champion of Champions: -** \$20 per player

**Interclub: -** \$140 + GST = \$161.00 per club side entered.

**Centre Bowls 3Five:-** \$20 per person

**All entry fees are payable to Centre Manager**

### **Bowls NZ Regulation Law 7.4**

**SUBSTITUTES** Please read this regulation in the Laws of the Sport of Bowls. Note- A substitute is now defined as a player who is either temporarily or permanently replacing an absent team member during a game or a tournament. All other aspects of the regulation remain unchanged.

---

### **Bowls NZ Regulation One**

**FOOTWEAR AND CLOTHING: PLEASE NOTE: Players / teams must strictly adhere to this regulation.**

This Regulation is supplementary to, and made in accordance with, Law 17.1 and Appendix A of the World Bowls Laws of the Sport of Bowls (Crystal Mark Edition), which permits Bowls NZ to make domestic regulations approving specific colours and types of footwear and types of soles, and specific colours and types of clothing for players, umpires, and markers when playing on the green or acting as umpires or markers.

**Team members for all Centre events:**

**ALL PLAYERS MUST APPEAR IN REGULATION BOWLING ATTIRE (Club Colours or Whites).**

#### **1. Definitions:**

- 1.1 The words and phrases used in this Regulation shall have the same meaning as defined in the Constitution of Bowls NZ, otherwise specified in these Regulations. For avoidance of doubt the conventions used in the World Bowls Laws of the Sport of Bowls (Crystal Mark Edition) shall not apply to this Regulation.
- 1.2 In addition to Clause 1.1 of this Regulation, the following words and phrases used in this Regulation shall mean as follows: “Club Tournament” means a competition, tournament or event for the game of bowls held by or under the auspices of a Club in which entry is limited to members of that Club. “Open Tournament” means a competition, tournament or event for the game of bowls which open to for entry to any member of any Club, or Centre. “Registered Umpire” means any person who is entered on the register maintained by the Bowls New Zealand Umpires Committee.

#### **2. Player’s Footwear**

Shoes or sandals may be worn by players when playing on a bowling green. All shoes must be flat soled and heel-less. Soles may be of a non-slip material with a slightly abrasive surface. Any Player with a physical disability may use an appropriate support, wheelchair or bowling aid, provided that the same is so made that its use causes no damage to the green.

#### **3. Player’s Clothing**

- 3.1 Club Tournaments: For Club Tournaments, playing attire shall be determined by the club.

- 3.2 Open Tournaments: For any Tournament other than a Club Tournament, players in Singles and members of Teams or Sides must wear garments of the same colour/ design as determined by the Tournament Controlling Body. Any garment may have logos displayed, but the Controlling Body may impose conditions relating to sponsor's logos to ensure that there is no conflict with a Tournament sponsor.
- 3.3 The Chief Executive of Bowls NZ may approve variations to clause 3.2 of this Regulation upon written application from any Centre for any specific events, games, Teams or Sides.
- 3.4 Bowling gloves may be worn at any time while playing bowls

#### **4. Umpires Clothing and Colours**

- 4.1 All Registered Umpires shall wear clothing in the official colours of tan and green, as approved by the Board of Bowls NZ.
- 4.2 Registered Umpires shall be entitled to wear such monograms, badges, flashes, blazers and other uniform items as shall be determined by the Board of Bowls NZ from time to time after consultation with the Bowls NZ Umpires Committee.
  - Registered Umpires function in the capacity of Law Umpire and Measurer.
  - Measurers function solely to determine upon request all physical measurements as required.
  - Law Umpires function solely on these written Laws.

---

#### **5. The Marker's Duties**

##### ***In the absence of an Umpire, the Marker should:***

- Make sure that all aspects of play are carried out in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls
- **Check before the game starts that:**
  - All bowls have a clearly visible, valid World Bowls Stamp imprinted on them.
  - The rink of play is the correct width in line with the law 5.1 by measuring it, and
  - The pegs or discs on the side banks in the direction of play are the correct distances in line with law 5.12 by measuring them.

##### **The Marker should:**

- Centre the Jack.
- Check that the Jack is at least 23 metres from the mat line after it has been centred.
- Place the Jack that comes to rest at less than 2m from the front ditch as described in law 22.2.
- Stand to one side of the rink, behind the Jack and away from the head.
- Answer any specific question about the state of the head which is asked by the player in possession of the rink.
- When asked, tell or show the player in possession of the rink the position of the Jack.
- When asked, tell or show the player in possession of the rink which bowl or bowls the Marker considers to be the shot.
- When authorised by the Controlling Body, signal to the player and spectators (using the appropriate number and colour of shot indicators or some other suitable method) which player's bowl or bowls the Marker considers to be the shot.
- Mark all the touches with chalk and remove the chalk marks from non-touches as soon as they come to rest.
- If both players agree, remove all dead bowls from the green of play.
- Mark the positions of a Jack and any touches which are in the ditch as describe in laws 24.4 and 29.2.
- Not move, or cause to be moved, either Jack or any bowls until the players have agreed the number of shots scored, and
- Measure any disputed shot or shots when asked to do so by either player. If the players are not satisfied with the Marker's decision the Marker should ask the Umpire to do the measuring. If the Controlling Body has not appointed an Umpire, the Marker should choose a competent neutral person to act as the Umpire. The Umpire's decision shall be final.

##### **When each end has been completed, the Marker should:**

- Record the score on the score card.



- Tell the players the running totals of the scores; and
- Remove from the rink the mat used from the previous end, if necessary.
- When the game has been completed, the Marker should make sure that the score card:
- Contains the names and the signatures of the players.
- Contains the times at which the game was completed; and is dealt with in line with the conditions of play.

---

### **WHAT “MARKERS” SHOULD NOT DO**

- ❖ Move about when the player is on the mat.
- ❖ Stand among the bowls.
- ❖ Stop the jack before it completes rolling.
- ❖ Move in to see who has shot unless asked.
- ❖ Answer questions relative to an adjacent rink.
- ❖ Answer a badly worded question.
- ❖ Supplement your answer with information not asked for.
- ❖ Talk to spectators or sit among them.
- ❖ Lean over sideways to “assist” a bowl to wick or miss.
- ❖ Applaud or direct a player. You are absolutely neutral.
- ❖ Talk to other markers unless players intend to drive

---

### **BFN Etiquette**

#### **ETIQUETTE IS SIMPLY GOOD MANNERS, TREATING OTHERS WITH RESPECT AND CONSIDERATION AT ALL TIMES.**

- ✓ Always be on time and ready to start, dress correct, shoes clean measures, chalk, coin, etc.
- ✓ Never walk up the green in front of a player on the mat.
- ✓ Walk in centre of own rink when changing ends – don’t stop. Stay at head if consultation is necessary.
- ✓ Everyone gathers in bowls.
- ✓ Be on good terms with your opponent.
- ✓ Always be ready to take your turn on the mat.
- ✓ Always line bowl from behind rink peg.
- ✓ Don’t talk when on bank – watch play at all times.
- ✓ Be meticulous on etiquette and fair play.
- ✓ Always encourage – never criticise.
- ✓ Be ready to help opponent with a long measure.
- ✓ Just prior to delivery of your bowl, make sure that the path of the bowl is clear, check the next rink in case a player is about to deliver their bowl.
- ✓ Do not talk or move about (if on the head) when a member of your team or the opposition is about to deliver their bowl.
- ✓ Place the skips bowl on the mat prior to changeover.
- ✓ Take an interest in the game – follow how the head is building up, you should not have to ask the skip the position of the head.
- ✓ Do not walk round talking to other players on the green; they might not be interested, especially if they are concentrating on their own game.
- ✓ Remember it is only a game and must be played in the best spirit of the game, this does not mean you should not have the determination to win.
- ✓ If beaten, take it sportingly – congratulate the winner and really mean it.
- ✓ **SKIPS** – all eyes are on you, do not become engrossed in conversation with the opposing Skip showing lack of interest in the game.

- ✓ Only the No 2 in triples and No. 3 in fours is responsible for measuring, let them do their job do not crowd them.
  - ✓ Warn players on adjoining – rinks that a drive is about to be played on your rink with the risk of disturbing bowls on their head. Endeavour to prevent this happening by guarding the side boundaries.
  - ✓ If you have borrowed a measure, pencil or pen, make sure you return it to the owner.
  - ✓ There is no need for improper language. It is out of place on a bowling green.
  - ✓ Does your share of marking for singles matches as you appreciate it when someone marks for you.
  - ✓ Thank the marker after a match – also thank an umpire after they have given a decision.
  - ✓ When the umpire is adjudicating, stand clear of the head.
  - ✓ Do not mingle with spectators and converse too freely with them, confine yourself to the game.
  - ✓ When having a roll up do not play amongst yourselves. Invite others, especially juniors to play with you.

## **Code of Conduct**

### **Introduction**

As a Representative of Bowls Far North incorporated a certain standard of behaviour is expected of you. These standards reflect the basic requirements of courtesy, professionalism and integrity which are required by our Representative Players.

### **Objectives**

1. To state plainly the way in which players who play in Bowls Far North events are expected to conduct themselves and the consequences of any breach of the expected standards of behaviour.
2. To ensure that all players are aware of the standards expected and the consequences of breaching those standards.

### **General:**

1. This code of conduct is to be followed on all occasions and in all places where the player can be seen to be a member of clubs under the jurisdiction of Bowls Far North and includes:
2. The venue of play which means the greens, surrounds and clubhouse of the place where the player is about to compete, or is competing or has competed.

### **Player's Obligations:**

#### **1. The Competition.**

***To maintain at all times a high standard of sportsmanship and fair play. This will of necessity include:***

- a. Always playing to the best of their ability and where appropriate to perform as part of a team.
- b. Abiding by Laws of the Game, it's Regulations and the Conditions of Play specified by the Controlling Body.
- c. Respecting and accepting without question any ruling given by the Umpire (subject to any right of appeal given by the Laws).
- d. Not to take any performance enhancing drug and in particular strictly to comply with any regulations adopted by Bowls Far North in regard thereto.
- e. Present him/her-self for competition in an acceptable physical and mental condition and standard of appearance.
- f. Maintain towards opponents an attitude of respect and politeness.
- g. No alcohol to be consumed on the green during play.
- h. No cell phones to be switched on when playing.

**Serious Breach of Conduct Code**

2. Any player who is dissatisfied by any action of the Convenor in relation to this Code of Conduct may require Bowls Far North to enquire into the conduct in question of the player in regards to it.

**Responsibilities of Team Managers and Team Officials**

1. To support responsibly the players while at the same time ensuring that any potential breach of this Code of Conduct is drawn to the attention of the player(s)
1. Where the Team Manager or responsible Official is satisfied that the breach of this Code of Conduct has occurred take responsible and appropriate action.
2. Report on any breach of this Code of Conduct, which has come to his/her attention to Bowls Far North.
