**World Bowls Laws of the Sport of Bowls**

**Crystal Mark Fourth Edition effective 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023**

CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR ALL CENTRE FIXTURES ARE SUBJECT TO ALTERATION AS PER LAW 55.3.4

### **Please Note:**

If after 10 (ten) minutes of the scheduled starting time for a game one or more players are absent from a team the defaulting team will forfeit the game to their opponents.

### **Reporting Time for Events:**

Report time: 8.00am

Trial ends: 8.10am

Start time: 8.30am

**Champion of Champion Events:** Where a player with dual membership wins a Championship event at more than one club, they must play the Centre Champion of Champion event for the first club at which they won the event.

**Entries:** All entry forms and entry fees for Centre Fixtures are to be forwarded by Club Secretary to the Centre Manager: [secretary@bowlsfarnorth.co.nz](mailto:secretary@bowlsfarnorth.co.nz)

Centre Tournaments and Champion of Champion Fixtures are now being played on a 2 (two) life system. The exception to this is the Bowls 3Five Playoff as per below.

**All Singles:** (including J1 and J1-5 Singles): 4 bowls each. 4 rounds per day of 21 shots up. Time limit of 2 hours. No time limit final/ possible final. All players are to bring a marker where possible. All players to mark the round immediately following elimination as directed by the Tournament Controller.

**All Pairs:** (including J1-5 Pairs): 3 Bowls each. 4 rounds per day of 18 completed ends. Time limit of 2 hours. No time limit final/ possible final.

**Triples:** 2 Bowls each. 4 rounds per day of 18 completed ends. Time limit of 2 hours. No time limit final/ possible final.

**Fours:** 2 Bowls each. 4 rounds per day of 15 completed ends. Time limit of 2 hours. No time limit final/ possible final.

**Mixed 2x4x2 Pairs:** 4 Bowls each. 2x4x2 format, 4 rounds per day of 14 completed ends. Time limit of 2 hours. No time limit final/ possible final.

**Supa Gold Card Triples:** 2 Bowls each. 4 rounds per day of 18 completed ends. Time limit of 2 hours. No time limit final/ possible final.

**Supa Gold Card Fours:** 2 Bowls each. 4 rounds per day of 15 completed ends. Time limit of 2 hours. No time limit final/ possible final.

**Bowls 3Five (Club):** Three members consisting of minimum one male & one female player. 2 Bowls each. 4 rounds per day of set play of two sets of 5 ends each. If a game is tied, a one-end tiebreaker is played to decide the winner. Club winner to progress to Bowls 3Five Centre event.

**Bowls 3Five (Centre):** Rules as per above. Each Club winners will play in sections depending on entries. Winners of each section playoff to determine Centre Winner. Winner progresses to near neighbour playoff against Northland Centre Winner.

**Restricting the movement of players during play:** In all games, players will only be allowed to walk up to the head under the following circumstances:

### **Singles:**

After the delivery of their third and fourth bowl.

### **Pairs:**

(Lead) After the delivery of their third bowl  
(Skip) After the delivery of their second bowl

**Triples:**

(Lead) After the delivery of their second bowl  
(Two) After the delivery of their second bowl  
(Skip) After the delivery of each of their bowls

**Fours:**

(Lead) After the second player in their team has played their second bowl  
(Two) After the delivery of their second bowl  
(Three) After the delivery of their second bowl  
(Skip) After the delivery of each of their bowls

**Centre Point to a Gold Star:** Each winner of a Centre Fixture gains a point towards a Centre Gold Star.

Exceptions are as follows

- J1-J5 Events: Winner must win Five J1-J5 events to be awarded a point.
- Supa Gold Card Events: No point awarded
- Bowls 3Five: No point awarded
- InterClub Events: No point awarded

**Centre Gold Star:** Presented to a bowler who has five Centre points to their credit.

**Centre Gold Bar:** Presented to a bowler who has 10 Centre points to their credit. Further Gold Bars presented in increments of five Centre points.

**Centre Certificate:** Certificates are awarded to winners of all Centre events. One certificate to be retained by the winners club and one for each team member “with the exception of the Interclub” also one certificate for each team member / player will be awarded to the runner up of all Centre events, once again, “with the exception of the Interclub”.

**Slow Play:** Players must play without undue delay and in a way which does not prevent their opponents from being able to complete the required number of ends within the time limit decided by the Controlling Body. A player in a time limit game can appeal to the Umpire or the Controlling Body for the time wasting or slow play of an opposing team or player.

## ***Umpires Duties***

### **Law 43 The Umpire's Duties**

- An umpire **must** be appointed by, or on behalf of, the Controlling Body for the competition.
  - the rink of play is the correct width in line with **Law 49.1** by measuring it; and
  - the pegs, discs or other types of markers on the side banks in the direction of play are the correct distances in line with **Law 49.12** by measuring them.
  - The umpire must measure any disputed shot or shots using suitable measuring equipment, such as that described in **Law 54**.

## ***Bowls NZ Domestic Regulations***

### **Status of Regulations**

These Domestic Regulations (Regulation) are made in accordance with Law 57.1 of the World Bowls Laws of the Sport of Bowls Crystal Mark Fourth Edition. This regulation applies to all Domestic play in New Zealand which covers club, centre, regional and national competitions.

Bowls New Zealand (as a Member National Authority) are authorised to make Regulations on aspects of the sport. If there is no domestic regulation to cover a specific aspect of the sport, all games will be played in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls. Commencement This Regulation is issued by Bowls New Zealand under Clause 25 of the Bowls New Zealand Constitution. This Regulation will take effect from 1 April 2023.

## ***Bowls NZ Regulation 2 – Substitute Players (Law32.9)***

**2.1** For domestic play, a substitute is a player who is either temporarily or permanently replacing an absent team member during a game or tournament.

**2.2** A Substitute may be permitted into a team at any stage during a game throughout the course of a tournament. Changes made to members of the original team before the start of the first game are permitted at the discretion of the Controlling Body and are not considered to be a substitute.

**2.3** The Controlling Body will decide on the eligibility and approve the use of a substitute. If no eligible substitute is available, Law 32.6 applies.

**Note:** The appointment shall be subject to approval by the controlling body.

# ***Bowls NZ Regulations***

**Team members for all Centre events:**

**ALL PLAYERS MUST APPEAR IN REGULATION BOWLING ATTIRE (Club Colours or Whites).**

## **1. Definitions**

- 1.1 The words and phrases used in this Regulation shall have the same meaning as defined in the Bowls New Zealand Constitution, unless otherwise specified in these Regulations.
- 1.2 References to a Law in this Regulation refers to a law in the World Bowls Laws of the Sport of Bowls Crystal Mark Fourth Edition.
- 1.3 “Club Tournament” means a competition, tournament, or event for the game of bowls held by or under the auspices of a Club in which entry is limited to members of that Club. This may include graded events where players play in a position that has been classified by their Club.
- 1.4 “Open Tournament” means a competition, tournament, or event for the game of bowls which is open for entry to any member of any Club or Centre.

## **2. Player’s Footwear**

- 2.1 Shoes or sandals may be worn by players when playing on a bowling green. All shoes must be flat soled and heel-less. Soles may be of a non-slip material with a slightly abrasive surface.
- 2.2 Any Player with a physical disability may use an appropriate support, wheelchair or bowling aid, provided that the same is so made that its use causes no damage to the green.

## **3. Colours and types of clothing, including bowling gloves (Appendix A.3)**

- 3.1 For club tournaments, clothing requirements shall be determined by the Club.
- 3.2 For any open tournament, players in Singles and members of a Team or Side must wear clothing of the same colour and design as determined by the Controlling Body. The Controlling Body may impose conditions relating to sponsor’s logos.
- 3.3 Bowls New Zealand may approve clothing variations upon application from any Club or Centre for any specific event, game, Team or Side.
- 3.4 Bowling gloves are permitted and may be worn at any time.
- 3.5 All registered Umpires will wear clothing in the official colours as determined by Bowls New Zealand. Umpires are entitled to wear badges, flashes, and other uniform items, as approved by Bowls New Zealand.

## **4. The Marker’s Duties**

In the absence of an Umpire, the Marker must:

- make sure that all aspects of play are carried out in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls;
- make sure, before the game starts, that:
  - all bowls have a clearly visible, valid World Bowls Stamp imprinted on them;
  - the rink of play is the correct width in line with law 49.1 by measuring it; and
  - the pegs, discs or other types of markers on the side banks in the direction of play are the correct distances in line with law 49.12 by measuring them.

**The Marker must:**

- check the mat is placed on the centre line of the rink;
- centre the jack;
- make sure that the jack is at least 23 metres from the mat line after it has been centred;
- place a jack that comes to rest less than 2 metres from the front ditch as described in law 9.2;
- stand to one side of the rink, behind the jack and away from the head;
- Answer any specific question about the state of the head which is asked by the player in possession of the rink;
- when asked, tell or show the player in possession of the rink the position of the jack;
- when asked, tell or show the player in possession of the rink which bowl or bowls the marker considers to be shot;

- when authorised by the Controlling Body, signal to players and spectators (using the appropriate number and colour of shot indicators or some other suitable method) which player's bowl or bowls the marker considers to be shot;
- mark all touchers with chalk and remove the chalk marks from non-touchers as soon as they come to rest;
- stop any bowl that is from a neighbouring rink and could move a jack or bowl that is at rest;
- if both players agree, remove all dead bowls from the rink of play;
- mark the position of a jack and any touchers which are in the ditch as described in laws 14.4 and 18.2;
- not move, or cause to be moved, either the jack or any bowls until the players have agreed the number of shots scored; and
- measure any disputed shot or shots when asked to do so by either player. If the players are not satisfied with the marker's decision, the marker must ask the umpire to do the measuring. If the Controlling Body has not appointed an umpire, the marker must choose a competent neutral person to act as the umpire. The umpire's decision is final. entre the Jack.

**When each end has been completed, the Marker should:**

- Record the score on the score card.
- if scoreboards are not being used, tell the players the running totals of the scores; and
- remove from the rink the mat used during the previous end, if necessary.

**When the game has been completed, the marker must make sure that the score card:**

- contains the names and signatures of the players;
- contains the time at which the game was completed; and
- is dealt with in line with the Conditions of Play.

**What Markers should not do**

- Move about when the player is on the mat.
- Stand among the bowls.
- Stop the jack before it completes rolling.
- Move in to see who has shot unless asked.
- Answer questions relative to an adjacent rink.
- Answer a badly worded question.
- Supplement your answer with information not asked for.
- Talk to spectators or sit among them.
- Lean over sideways to "assist" a bowl to wick or miss.
- Applaud or direct a player. You are absolutely neutral.
- Talk to other markers unless players intend to drive

## ***BFN Etiquette***

ETIQUETTE IS SIMPLY GOOD MANNERS, TREATING OTHERS WITH RESPECT AND CONSIDERATION AT ALL TIMES.

- Be on time. Timekeeping is perhaps one of the oldest rules of courtesy.
- Dress appropriately
- Stand still when someone is about to bowl
- Be alert as you walk around adjacent rinks
- Observe the rules of possession
- Acknowledgements are in order
- Do not drop that bowl
- Shake hands

# Code of Conduct

## Introduction

As a Representative of Bowls Far North incorporated a certain standard of behaviour is expected of you. These standards reflect the basic requirements of courtesy, professionalism and integrity which are required by our Representative Players.

## Objectives

1. To state plainly the way in which players who play in Bowls Far North events are expected to conduct themselves and the consequences of any breach of the expected standards of behaviour.
2. To ensure that all players are aware of the standards expected and the consequences of breaching those standards.

## General

1. This code of conduct is to be followed on all occasions and in all places where the player can be seen to be a member of clubs under the jurisdiction of Bowls Far North and includes:
2. The venue of play which means the greens, surrounds and clubhouse of the place where the player is about to compete, or is competing or has competed.

## Player's Obligations

### 1. The Competition.

***To maintain at all times a high standard of sportsmanship and fair play. This will of necessity include:***

1. Always playing to the best of their ability and where appropriate to perform as part of a team.
2. Abiding by Laws of the Game, it's Regulations and the Conditions of Play specified by the Controlling Body.
3. Respecting and accepting without question any ruling given by the Umpire (subject to any right of appeal given by the Laws).
4. Not to take any performance enhancing drug and in particular strictly to comply with any regulations adopted by Bowls Far North in regard thereto.
5. Present him/her-self for competition in an acceptable physical and mental condition and standard of appearance.
6. Maintain towards opponents an attitude of respect and politeness.
7. No alcohol to be consumed on the green during play.
8. No cell phones to be switched on when playing.
9. Abide by the dress codes as in the Conditions of Play.

### 2. Other Occasions

1. To refrain from:
  - a. Any behaviour that might reflect unfavourably on the Game of Bowls Far North, or that might bring any other player, official or Bowls Far North into disrepute.
  - b. Making any comment to the media and in particular any public announcement or media comment that might bring the game into disrepute.
  - c. Any discriminatory practises based on race, religion, ethnic background or special Ability/disability bowlers.
2. Abide by:
  - a. And comply with all the directions of Bowls Far North.
  - b. Accept and act upon any judgement of any duly appointed official of Bowls Far North as to any unacceptable behaviour.
  - c. The requirements of Bowls Far North as to dress including sponsor's logos.
  - d. Respect the tournament officials, volunteers, officers, at all times.
  - e. Respect the Officers and appointed officials of Bowls Far North.

**Serious Breach of Conduct Code**

1. If the Convenor, having heard any explanation that the player concerned may proffer, is satisfied that the player is in serious breach of this Code of Conduct, the Convenor may withdraw that player from the event.
2. Any player who is dissatisfied by any action of the Convenor in relation to this Code of Conduct may require Bowls Far North to enquire into the conduct in question of the player in regards to it.

**Responsibilities of Team Managers and Team Officials**

1. To support responsibly the players while at the same time ensuring that any potential breach of this Code of Conduct is drawn to the attention of the player(s)
2. Where the Team Manager or responsible Official is satisfied that the breach of this Code of Conduct has occurred take responsible and appropriate action.
3. Report on any breach of this Code of Conduct, which has come to his/her attention to Bowls Far North.
